- 72.6 % zoned for manufacturing
- 9.9% of residential land use in manufacturing zones.

Analysis of transportation

- 16% of people walk to work (higher than Brooklyn average)

Carroll Gardens Association properties.

- 20 properties, 7 on Columbia, 11 in Red Hook
